FIRST NOTICE

What is this Activity?

It is a Patrol based activity, with a Mystery theme! More will be revealed, either just before the Camp, or during the activity.

Come along for an exciting weekend, and meet other Scouts from throughout Manningham District.

Your challenge

As a Patrol, to travel from Templestowe to a number of specified points, somewhere in Victoria. All participants will meet at a specified point for Saturday lunch, and at another specified location for Saturday night. Other things will happen on the Sunday.

You will have with you a "Dummy" (Leader/parent) who is there for your safety – they can only assist you if you look to be about to do something that will endanger you and/or your patrol. Treat your "Dummy" well – they are essential to you accomplishing the tasks.

As you leave Point A the "Dummy" will give you information about activities and tasks that you are to undertake. All members of your Patrol must work together to achieve the goals and tasks. You and your Patrol will need to produce a plan giving details of timing, pricing, and program showing how you plan to achieve the tasks. Don't forget to add to your plan what badge work is being covered for each member of the Patrol.

Departure

Departure time will be confirmed nearer the Camp, but is likely to be at the Blackburn Train Station Scout Hall at around 8.30 am on Saturday 22 September.



Personal Gear

A Personal Gear list will be provided closer to the Camp. Lightweight travelling is essential - each member of the Patrol must be able to carry his or her own gear easily. (No tents required.) A drink bottle is essential.

Location - A mystery!!

What will you be doing?- Also a mystery!!

Cost - The cost for the weekend is likely to be around \$30 to \$35– a firm cost will be provided within the next couple of weeks. The cost covers transport costs, meals and accommodation.

Food - Will be discussed and organised closer to the Camp.

Reply Slip

If you want to come along for a great weekend, get your parents to complete the attached Reply Slip and return to Scouts on next week (15th September) or to a Leader before then.

We need to advise District who will be attending as soon as possible – so please make sure to bring along your Reply Slip next week.
