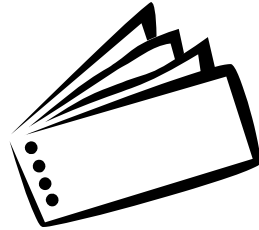

Raffle Tickets

On Friday 22nd February all families in the Scout / Venturer sections were issued with 2 books of Raffle Tickets. The Raffle, which is being organised by the Victorian Branch of the Scout Association, is an easy way for our group to raise money to help fund our Scout Group. All money raised from the sale of the tickets goes to the Scout Troop and Venturer Unit.

Selling a ticket:

Each ticket is worth \$2 and must be sold for that value. When selling a ticket it is critical that you or the ticket purchaser fill in the stub for that ticket being sold so we can contact them if they win.

Return of money, ticket stubs:

Please note that all tickets stubs and unsold tickets and money must be returned to us by Friday 11th March 2008.

Lost / stolen tickets:

If you lose a ticket book you need to complete a statutory declaration declaring that the tickets have not been sold and return it to Matthew.

Patrol competition:

The patrol that sells the most tickets on average per person will win dinner one night before Scouts/Venturers begins.

If you wish to sell more than 2 books, please contact Matthew and he will organise you some more books.
